

HEAL THE WORLD

Through the generosity of Cornerstone members, we were able to provide support, hope and healing to our community, near and abroad. While consistently supporting organizations like the Pregnancy Center, Mom's House of Toledo, Martin Luther King Kitchen for the Poor and Cherry Street Mission, we were able to support some new organizations like Cru, a university campus ministry group. Cornerstone volunteers also participated in hospital, nursing home and prison inmate visitation throughout the year.

WOW JAM 2014 was an outdoor block party in front of the Cornerstone Eastwood Theater campus. Stephen and Linda Tavani performed a live concert and ministered to hundreds of East Toledo families. Cornerstone volunteers connected with residents by taking family photos, playing games with children, cutting hair and giving out over 200 bags of groceries. Over 461 people received salvation and 289 were baptized that day. We are excited that many of those families are now a part of our Cornerstone Eastwood Theater campus and family.








Cornerstone Academy, located in Odokono N'kwanta, Ghana, continues to thrive as enrollment numbers increase and students excel academically and in co-curricular activities. An additional 7-room block building was added this year to provide Junior High classrooms to accommodate the increased enrollment and student advancement. Due to the faithful commitment Cornerstone Church has made to Cornerstone Academy, the Ghanaian government installed an additional water well and an electric light pole allowing for wiring of the school buildings so that computers and other electrical devices can be used to further enhance student education.

For many years we have partnered with ministries focused on healing the world internationally. Partners like Christine Caine and the A21 campaign, which focuses on freeing women and children from the atrocities of human trafficking and Dr. Patricia Bailey of Master's Touch Ministries. This year we were able to partner with Dr. Bailey to provide water filters to needy villages, a water irrigation system for village crops and the first ultrasound machine in the nation of Togo to assist with women's healthcare providing increased safety during pregnancy.

CORNERSTONE CHURCH AT THE EASTWOOD THEATER

On Saturday, August 2, Cornerstone Church launched its Eastwood Campus! Services are held weekly, on Saturdays at 5:00PM. The first services were held outside under a tent for all that live in the community to see and hear. Each week our teams are going into the neighborhoods healing the sick, bringing freedom to those that are bound and proclaiming the Good News of Jesus Christ. As a result we are hearing testimony after testimony of people having life-changing experiences with Jesus.







On November 8, the Eastwood Theater hosted their Grand Reopening Celebration. Over one-hundred city officials, school superintendents, college representatives, and passionate community partners filled the lobby with laughter, memories and well-wishes as they toured the newly-renovated facility. Ohio State Representative Sheehy presented a declaration honoring the Eastwood Theater project, recognizing the impact it has already had on the East Toledo neighborhood. Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur presented a flag to Bishop Pitts that had been flown over the U.S. Capitol in honor of the Eastwood Theater. She has followed the progress and diligent work of Cornerstone Church for some time and thanked him personally for all he has done for this city. She agrees with Cornerstone's declaration that *Cities Can Be Won*.



This ministry is specifically designed to Engage, Enrich, Involve and Evangelize young adults ages 18-30. Through regular gatherings in small groups for social nights and outreach events participants are able to grow deeper together. Core team members in this group also lead worship services at the University of Toledo campus for college students.





This year, new systems were added throughout Spectrum to enhance both the child and parent experience. Sound equipment and software were installed throughout elementary classrooms. Updated media software was also added in KL7 to further develop sound-technician skills and provide more hands-on experience before youth transition into the sanctuary roles. Parents transitioned to a new child check-in system that features text messaging and barcode check-in capabilities. The Spectrum Store is now open before and after every service.



SKILLS CAMP - "Ordinary Kids, Doing Extraordinary Things" was the theme for Skills Camp 2014. This week-long day camp offered to kids ages 7-16, hosted over 250 campers this year. Campers participated in a sport or art camp, had lunch and then met in the main sanctuary for more fun and the ministry of Pastor Ricardo and Isha Miller. We concluded the week with a Skills Camp Service for the entire family, showcasing the talent, learning and hard work of our campers. Every camper and volunteer gave their best this week with loads of enthusiasm for praising God and sharing His love with one another.





TRUNK & TREAT

This annual fall event included 500 children treating for candy from trunk to trunk! People of all ages were dressed for the occasion and children went home with a bag full of candy. Prizes were awarded for best decorated trunk and best costumes. Cornerstone staff competed for weeks to collect the most donated candy to distribute during Trunk & Treat. Fun was had by all during this "Sweet Rivalry," resulting in trunk loads of candy. At the conclusion of the evening's activities, the contest winner delivered a friendly pie in the face to the contestant with the least amount of candy donated.

A big celebration for the birth of Jesus is held every year in Spectrum. This year was no different. It's always a wondrous occasion as elementary children express their love and appreciation for their moms, dads, siblings, grandparents and teachers by using their points and shopping at our Mega-Store, while learning that Jesus is the reason for the season.



Interactive worship services, fun special events and meaningful outreach activities are the core of the Emerge ministry.

Emerge focuses on youth 12 – 17 years old, with specific programming for Jr. High and High School students respectively. The year began with a special night for Emerge girls during the Inspired Conference, with the topic “Strength for your Journey.” Youth also participated in a retreat at Camp Michindoh that included 72 hours of God, fun and fellowship. Emerge youth were sent into the community for Global Youth Service Day, assisting Partners for Clean Streams with marking storm drains. CREW RALLY








FACILITIES RENOVATIONS

This year we completed much needed renovations to the Parish Relations offices, guest lobby, work room and kitchen area. These renovations created expanded, better usable spaces with an upgraded, more welcoming and contemporary feel. We also completed the landscaping projects in the South and East Parking Lots that both improve appearance and reduce costs of maintenance and up-keep.

Facilities staff, construction crews and dozens of Cornerstone volunteers dedicated much of the spring and summer to the restoration of the historic Eastwood Theater in East Toledo. In addition to all of the “behind the walls” work in wiring, HVAC, plumbing and lighting, the team completed floor and chair replacement, installation of media and sound systems, room redesign, exterior paint and signage and gave the building new curb appeal. It was a massive project that resulted in the reopening of the historic theater as both a Cornerstone Campus and functioning movie theater.




